

## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- 1. USTA Rules will govern play.
- 2. If there is a change in the draw, it must be reported to the tournament director at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the tournament. Only players not in the draw may be substituted.
- 3. The coach is required to be in attendance at the courts whenever any of their players are competing. In case of emergencies, arrangements must be made with the tournament director.
- 4. Any postponement or suspension of play will be determined by the tournament director. All matches will be played as scheduled.
- 5. Players must have knowledge of the rules, including the tie-breaking procedure.
- 6. The server must call the score so that it can be heard by the opponent(s) and spectators on every point.
- 7. Warm-up balls are the responsibility of the player/team. Match balls will be provided by the tournament director and are to be returned upon completion of the match.
- 8. Check in time will be 15 minutes prior to the scheduled match time. The scheduled match time will be the official default time.
- 9. A five minute warm-up, including serves, will be allowed.
- 10. Two out of three sets and the 7 point tie-breaker will be used. During 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> rounds, a match tie-break (10-point) will be played in lieu of a third set.
- 11. Once play begins, it shall be continuous. Players are not to leave the court. In <u>girls'</u> competition <u>only</u>, a break is allowed after the 2<sup>nd</sup> set, not to exceed 10 minutes.
- 12. A player's high school coach is the only person authorized to talk to or coach a player during a match and then only during a court change.
- 13. There shall be no questioning of calls. If necessary, the tournament director will appoint a neutral coach to serve as referee.
- 14. Inappropriate court conduct:
  - First infraction point
  - Second infraction loss of game
  - Third infraction forfeit of match
