
- 1. There will be a Coach's meeting 30 minutes prior to the first race located at the finish line.
- 2. The course is dirt with hills, with sandy areas and a pavement finish.
- 3. This will be a bib number meet. **Bib numbers are to be worn on the front of singlet** We will be hand scoring the meet
- 4. No camps, no tents, no access to the stadium. Also no bicycles or pets are allowed on the course. No Hats or visors allowed
- 5. Three Port-A-Pots will be provided at the start area
- 6. Masks must be worn by all athletes and coaches at all times.
- 7. Recommend to not wear spikes because we finish on asphalt.
- 8. There will be no awards, hence no awards ceremony.
- There will be another Coach's meeting after the last race. Please double check the NMAA State Qualifying form for all spellings. Make sure you put the athletes <u>that you wish to compete</u> at the State Meet <u>on the State Qualifying form.</u>
- 10. An Athletic Trainer will be provided
- 11. Results will be emailed to coaches, NMmilesplit.com, ABQ Journal, APS and the NMAA for the State Qualifying forms as soon as I leave the stadium.

Qualifying for State Championships
